

Owl Mother's Day Card

Theme: Comparing Sizes

Instructions

Mums love owls, and if you need a simple, cheap Mother's Day card idea that all of the children can enjoy making, then this is an ideal project. Use the templates on the next page to cut the shapes out ready for the children to glue down.

This project is designed to allow you to observe how well the children get along comparing sizes when gluing down the three concentric circles that make up the eyes.



EYFS Observations

EYFS Learning and Development Area:

Mathematics: Shape, Space and Measure

Early Learning Goals:

Use the words 'circle' 'bigger' 'smaller' to describe shapes and everyday language to describe their positions 'top' 'middle' 'bottom' etc.

What to look for on this project:

- 16-26 months How do the young children attempt to fit the 3 circles together on the paper?
- 22-36 months Can the children find which circle is bigger and which is smaller? Can they order the circles by size?
- 30-50 months Can the children use the word 'circle' correctly? Can they order the circles by size?
- 40-60 months Can the children use words like 'bigger' or 'smaller' correctly? Can they order the three circles correctly on the paper by size?
